Designating a space

• garage, basement, or spare bedroom

Designing that space

- size doesn't matter, inspiration does
- good ventilation (window or fume extractor)
- flooring: hard surface tile, wood or industrial
- bench surface: solid and sturdy
- water supply
- storage: think practical reach, children or pets
- safety: strap your tank, fire extenguisher, goggles and mask

Tools

- the basics: pliers, files, hammers, saw, bench block...
- · bench pin: its personal
- flexi shaft and all its fiddly bits. Where do I start?
- torch: strap in place, light with striker only, set psi to 5*
- torch assembly: always test the joins with soapy water

Silversmithing stuff

- solder and silver (dead soft, etc)
- flux (boric acid)
- pickle (sodium bisulfate) nuetralize with baking soda

Q&A

* Acetylene main valve should only be opened 1/4 turn, and the regulator set at 5 to 7 psi (pounds per square inch). (If acetylene is turned up too high, it can become unstable.) On a two gauge regulator there is a Cylinder Pressure Gauge (tank is full or empty) and a Working Pressure Gauge pressure in the hose.


